



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



BETWEEN

THE TONLE SAP AUTHORITY

AND

THE NANJING RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF HYDROLOGY AND WATER
CONSERVATION AUTOMATION

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as “MOU”) is entered between the Tonle Sap Authority (TSA) and the Nanjing Research Institute of Hydrology and Water Conservation Automation (NIHWA), hereinafter referred to individually as “Party” and collectively as “Parties”.

Tonle Sap Authority (TSA) In pursuance of sustainable management, conservation, and development of Tonle Sap Lake Region for long live heritage of our humanity, Samdech Techo Hun Sen (Prime Minister of Kingdom of Cambodia) has established an institution under the management of Council of Ministers and as a direct General for the Royal Government of Cambodia which is Tonle Sap Authority under Royal Decree NS/RKT/0907/412 dated 08 September 2007. From the observation of actual situation, Royal Government had amended management and responsibilities structure on the management competent scope of Tonle Sap Basin Authority to become Tonle Sap Authority under Royal Decree NS/RKT/0609/705 dated 29 June 2009 and Royal Decree NS/RKT/0310/258 dated 24 March 2010 stated on the amendment of Article 3, Article 5, Article 10, and Article 12 on the establishment of Tonle Sap Authority.

Nanjing Research Institute of Hydrology and Water Conservation Automation (NIHWA), subordinated to the Ministry of Water Resources of China, specializes in fundamental research and key technology development in fields of flood and drought management, water environment and aquatic ecosystem monitoring and water project operation management, contributing to automated, information-based and smart water conservancy.

The Parties decide to jointly advance the implementation of The Pilot Project of Hydrological Data Observation and Transmission Technology for Tonle Sap Basin in Cambodia (hereinafter referred to as “the project”), according to the implementation plan of project drafted by NIHWA and signed by both Parties.

The Parties will further develop specific work plans and conduct joint activities to ensure the successful completion of the project.

The Parties will report to higher authorities on progress of cooperation.

The Parties decide to designate the responsible contacts for the cooperation under this MOU as follows:

TSA: **H.E. Mr. Mao Hak**, Vice Chairman of Tonle Sap Authority (TSA), Ministry of Water Resources and Meteorology, Cambodia

NIHWA: **Li Chenxi**, Project Coordinator, Senior Engineer, Department of International Cooperation of NIHWA, China.

The MOU does not create any rights or legally binding obligations upon both Parties and does not constitute a treaty under international law.

This MOU will become effective from the date of signature by both Parties and be terminated on the date when the project is completed and accepted.
